

# Boomer Fall Basketball League CoVid-19 Procedures

#### Assumption: Masks and Social Distancing Required Indoors

Below is the outline to safely operate Boomer Fall League. These guidelines are approved by JCC and Jay County Health Department and follow the Back On Track Indiana Plan. Please be patient and follow the guidelines to insure a successful and safe league. Please remember all dates and restrictions are subject to change and are dependent upon the progress of the state's back on track Indiana plan. Kyle Cook and Mitch Waters are in charge of compliance of this plan. This plan will be distributed via email, text, Facebook and print form will be available at the concession stands.

### JCC Responsibilities:

- All employees and volunteers will be required to face coverings
- All employees and volunteers must self-assess for any potential COVID-19 symptoms and temperatures will be taken prior to their shifts. Employees and Volunteers must stay home if symptoms consistent with COVID-19 are present.
- If someone has tested positive in your immediate household for COVID or you are a close contact of a COVID positive individual in the last 14 days you cannot attend league
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be readily available at multiple locations during the show
- HVAC vent fans will be on to circulate fresh air continuously during the show
- There will be three entrances and exits one for each basketball court to limit lines and wait time
- Stagger start times of games to reduce games overlapping
  - Parents will be encouraged to stay in their cars until five minutes prior to their scheduled game time.
  - Teams will play more back to back games to limit traffic in the facility that aren't actively watching or playing
- No bleachers will be utilized (unless JCC is staffed heavy enough to clean the bleachers after games)
- Attendance will be limited to maintain social distancing
- Signage will be posted around the facility, by JCC, to abide by social distancing 6 feet and screening for COVID symptoms consistent with COVID. Please follow the guidelines and self-police
- A compliance checklist will be located at the concession stand documenting when high touch areas were last cleaned and social distancing inspections
  - Restrooms and high touch areas will be disinfected at 1, 3, 5 and 7
  - o Social distancing checks will be completed hourly
- Concession Stand
  - All concession staff will be required to wear mask and gloves.
  - JCC may provide a limited menu of prepackaged good like drinks, candy etc....
  - A cleaning crew will come in at the conclusion of the game



## Boomer Fall Basketball League CoVid-19 Procedures

### **Parent/Visitor Responsibilities:**

- Parents and players are encouraged to leave their courts immediately after the game to make room for the new teams and fans. Please use your designated Entrance and Exit
- Parents/guardians are asked to not loiter at the facility once the games are complete
- Parents must pick up all trash and place it in the trash containers closest to them.
- There will be no bleachers or team benches. Please plan accordingly.
- If someone has tested positive for COVID-19 in your household or been in close contact of a COVID positive individual in the last 14 days you will not be able to attend practices and/or game. JCC and/or your coach need contacted immediately.
- If your child is sick or has symptoms consistent with COVID don't attend the games
- Visitors will also be required to wear face coverings for those 8 years and older while at JCC per governor Holcomb's executive order. Exceptions will be made for people with medical issues, strenuous physical activity, and when you are eating or drinking.
- Signage will be posted around facility, by JCC, to abide by social distancing 6 feet. Please follow the guidelines.
- All attendees must practice social distancing

### Player and Coach's Responsibilities to Social Distancing:

- All players shall always practice social distancing when not actively playing
- We recommend that no player share equipment and game balls should be sanitized at the start of each game
- All teams must pick up their areas at the conclusion of the games
- It is recommended that all players sanitize their practice balls after each use
- It is recommended that all and parents have access to hand sanitizer
- There will be no huddles allowed before, during or after games that are not following the social distancing guidelines.
- Coaches are expected to organize their team and gear immediately at the conclusion of their game. Players, coaches, and fans will be expected to leave the court area immediately to make room for the new teams and fans.

### Jay County Basketball Club Practice Procedures;

- All players are recommended to have their own practice equipment.
- Disinfectant, wipes, and hand sanitizer will be located in each gym
- Any JCC equipment utilized during practices must be disinfected prior to being returned
- All coaches, volunteers and players must self-assess for any potential COVID-19 symptoms. Coaches, volunteer and/or players must stay home if symptoms consistent with COVID-19 are present.
- Please limit attendance and loitering at JCC during and after practices
- Coaches must check in, check out and give projected attendance for their practices to the front desk
- Parents and players are recommended to use the senior center exit or the parking lot exit in the large gym to limit congestion at the front desk area

Any team, coaches or players who are violating these expectations will be asked to leave the facility and not to return for the safety of all players and spectators
