

Boomer Flag Football and Soccer CoVid-19 Procedures

Below is the outline to safely operate Boomer Fall Soccer and Flag Football. These guidelines have been reviewed by Waste Management, Jay County Health Department, and the JCC board of directors and follow the Back On Track Indiana Plan. Please be patient and follow the guidelines to insure a successful and safe league. Please remember all dates and restrictions are subject to change and are dependent upon the progress of the state's back on track Indiana plan. Baxter Holdcroft and Mitch Waters are in charge of compliance of this plan. This plan will be distributed via email, text, Facebook and print form will be available at the concession stands.

Boomer Flag Football and Soccer CoVid-19

JCC Responsibilities:

- Stagger start times of games to reduce games overlapping
 - Parents will be encouraged to stay in their cars until ten minutes prior to their scheduled game time.
 - Warm up fields will be available to for teams preparing to play
- Signage will be posted around fields, by JCC, to abide by social distancing 6 feet and screening for COVID symptoms consistent with COVID. Please follow the guidelines and self-police
- JCC will have to limit attendees if proper social distancing isn't being achieved consistently
- JCC will sanitize game balls after each game
- Face coverings are recommended by the governor's executive order 20-37
- All employees and volunteers must self-assess for any potential COVID-19 symptoms and temperatures will be taken prior to their shifts. Stay home if symptoms consistent with COVID-19 are present.
- A compliance checklist will be located at the concession stand documenting when high touch areas were last cleaned and social distancing inspections
- Concession Stand and Restrooms:
 - Please be patient. There will be a line for payment and a line for ordering
 - All concession staff will be required to wear mask and gloves and be behind a protective barrier
 - Portable bathrooms will be sanitized and serviced by Barnes Sewer and Septic
 - o JCC may provide a limited menu of prepackaged good like drinks, candy etc....
 - JCC staff will sanitize high touch areas hourly
 - Markings will be put on the ground to indicate social distancing
 - A protective barrier will be installed at the concession window



Parent Responsibilities:

- There will be no bleachers or team benches. Please plan accordingly.
- No smoking permitted on the grounds, permitted in parking lot.
- Parents must pick up all trash and place it in the trash containers closest to them.
- Parents are encouraged to park close to their playing field
- Parents and players are encouraged to leave their field immediately after the game to make room for the new teams and fans.
- If someone has tested positive for COVID-19 in your household or been in close contact of a COVID positive individual in the last 14 days you will not be able to attend practices and/or game. JCC and/or your coach need contacted immediately.
- If your child is sick or has symptoms consistent with COVID don't attend the games
- Face coverings are recommended by the governor's executive order 20-37 especially in situations when social distancing can't be achieved

Player and Coach's Responsibilities to Social Distancing:

- All players shall always practice social distancing when no actively playing
- We recommend that no player share equipment and game balls should be sanitized at the start of each game
- All teams must pick up their areas at the conclusion of the games
- It is recommended that all players sanitize their practice balls after each use
- It is recommended that all and parents have access to hand sanitizer
- There will be no huddles allowed before, during or after games that are not following the social distancing guidelines.

Any team, coaches or players who are violating these expectations will be asked to leave the facility and not to return for the safety of all players and spectators
